July Highlights

- Although our RV was broken down, God still allowed us to travel from our Ohio home base.
- We presented our ministry in North Carolina, helped with a Vacation Bible School in Michigan, and finished the month with Mario preaching at our home church celebrating our Pastor and his wife's 44th anniversary at the church!

August Highlights

- Attended a Vision and Planning Conference at a camp in Virginia where we received valuable insight from pastors, a lawyer, a CPA, a professional fundraiser, and a camp owner.

In our last letter, we mentioned the challenges with our RV insurance claim. After seeking counsel from pastors and the CLA, it became clear that we needed legal help. We retained an attorney two weeks ago, trusting the Lord to guide us in this unfamiliar process. The retainer cost was overwhelming at first, but after much prayer, we had peace to proceed. Just four days later, our monthly support check arrived—and it was the largest we've ever received, covering the exact amount we needed for the retainer fee. Praise the Lord for His perfect provision! This time and effort is not in vain. Once the claim is settled, we plan to launch Promised Land Xperience (PLX), a ministry to bring Camp Promised Land directly to churches. We're excited about this next step and look forward to sharing more details and a launch date soon!
