Our top praises this quarter:

1. We are praising the Lord that our relative with the cancer diagnosis is cancer free!!! Thank you so much for your prayers through this battle!
2. At a recent meeting we got last minute, the church sent us off with an \$1800 love offering and freezer full of meat from a local farm! It was such an unexpected and overwhelming blessing!
3. We are so thankful for the six churches that have welcomed us to use their rv hookups at no expense to us as well as an RV Park that heard about our mission and gifted us with a free stay!
4. Unfortunately, our truck tire got a nail stuck in it. It was passed the point of a patch and would be a \$400 replacement on top of the other truck maintenance we had to take care of. We are so thankful for how God provided nearly \$1,000 to get everything taken care of just by bringing our burdens to Him.
5. This might seem like a small praise to some, but Emily was praying for a walking pad (a compact treadmill). She found a used one for \$150 and prayed God would provide the money. The day before she was supposed to get it, 2 letters came in the mail. One had a \$50 bill and the other had a check for \$100! Our Heavenly Father is so wonderful to care about those seemingly small details in our lives.

We feel so overwhelmed by the Goodness of God and how He uses the sweet people we've met along the way. Our hearts have been encouraged and "excited" would be an understatement for how we feel about this next chapter!
